



## MAGICAL KENYA OPEN 2023

All attending the Magical Kenya Open need to apply for a **Tourist Visa and have the proper covid document for entry.**

### **Visa information:**

All nationalities must apply for the "Single Entry" visa online at least 5 days in advance. The cost is approximately \$51.

Required documents to attach in your application which the eVisa website requires must be in jpeg format:

- Travel itinerary (details about places to visit if going as a tourist)
- Hotel booking confirmation.
- Return air ticket.
- Clear Passport biodata page
- A clear headshot photograph.

If you require an invitation letter to apply for your visa (**note:** this only applies to a few nationalities) please email [visa.admin@europeantourgroupp.com](mailto:visa.admin@europeantourgroupp.com)

Passports must be valid for more than 6 months after your date of entry with 2 blank pages.

**NOTE:** It was the intention of the Magical Kenya Open organisers, in conjunction with the Kenyan authorities to issue all persons travelling to the 2023 Magical Kenya Open with a visa waiver. At the time of publishing this has not been possible, however it is the intention to issue a retrospective refund. More details on this process to follow.

### **Covid requirements:**

All travellers to Kenya are required to show proof of either a Covid-19 vaccine certificate or a negative Covid-19 PCR test conducted no more than 72hrs before departure.

**Reminder:** You will need to upload your vaccination certificate or PCR test onto the [PanaBIOS \(or Global Haven\) website](#) before arrival (a QR code will be issued)
